PRAYERS THIS WEEK are based on M.A.F. MISSION AVIATION FELLOWSHIP.

SUNDAY

<u>U.K.</u>:Praise God that in 2023 MAF's amazing volunteers spoke at more than 400 meetings across the U.K. Give thanks for the H.Q. staff at Folkestone as they continue to raise awareness of MAF's mission to see isolated people changed by the love of Christ.

MONDAY

<u>Papua-New Guinea</u>: MAF Staff recently assisted the Baptism of 30 young people at RUM, a small village in the mountains. Pray for these enthusiastic believers as they work out their new-found faith.

TUESDAY

Kenya: MAF flies to 50 different airstrips in Kenys. Pray for good relationships with the communities near each one. It's by this that the runways can be kept clear and grass short enough for aircraft to land safely.

WEDNESDAY

Chad: 40% of the population in Chad calls itself Christian, and MAF Teams often fly boxes of Bibles to rural communities. Pray that what believers read will stir their hearts to be a witness and encouragement to those around them.

THURSDAY

<u>South Sudan</u>: Give thanks that following the delivery of over 5 tonnes of solar powered equipment, villages and charity workers benefit from solar panels, lights and vaccine fridges; saving lives and helping those in need.

FRIDAY

<u>Guinea:</u> Without adequate supplies of fuel MAF's planes cannot fly. Pray for an effective long-term solution to the fuel shortage in Guinea, caused by an explosion in the country's main fuel depot. Pray too, for those who lost loved ones as a result of the blast.

SATURDAY

<u>Timor-Leste:</u> has just two aircraft and nine staff members, flying more than 3,400 passengers last year. MAF is the only provider of an air-ambulance service – give thanks that MAF can fly ill and injured patients to hospital at no extra cost to the patient.
