This week we have received prayers from the Bible Society, for Gambia, and these will be used in some of our Daily Prayers. The country is very small on the very west of Africa with a population of 2½ million. Official language-English

Sunday: Father God, today we pray for our visiting Preacher, Andy Twilley. Bless him as he conducts our worship. Bless him for all the work he does for the URC all over the Southern Synod.

Friday: Father God, we thank you that we are able to worship you in our open church. Lord keep us all safe we pray. But we know that many of our friends are bereaved and are sad even though Christmas approaches. Be with them especially.

Saturday: O Lord, support us all through the long day of our lives, until the shadows lengthen and the evening comes, and the busy world Is hushed, and the fever of life over, and our work is done. Then Lord, in your mercy, grant us a safe lodging, a holy rest, and peace at the last.
