PRAYERS FOR THE WEEK

Sunday: Let all the world in every corner sing, 'My God and King!' The heavens are not too high, his praise may thither fly, the earth is not too low, his praises there may grow. Let all the world in every corner sing, 'My God and King!'

Monday: Tearfund in Afghanistan: Let us pray for those in Afghanistan affected by three major earthquakes: 2,200 people have died and more than 3,600 people have been injured. Lord comfort those facing loss of loved ones, homes and livelihoods

Tuesday: Let us pray for the people of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) - for an end to the violence in eastern DRC. Pray for peace to allow people to return to their homes and livelihoods. More than 20 million people need help to recover from the on going conflict to rebuild their lives.

Wednesday: Gaza and Israel: Pray for all civilians in Gaza and across the region - that God would protect them from harm, particularly the most vulnerable; children, older people and people with disabilities. Pray for church leaders - for wisdom and strength to lead people through fear and anxiety. Pray for bravery as they guide their communities and offer loving support.

Thursday: Pray for Pakistan after flooding. Lift up all those who have lost loved ones, homes, livelihoods and livestock. May God comfort them and give them peace and strength. May they they have everything they will need as they face the challenge of rebuilding their lives. Pray for no more destruction over the coming weeks as the monsoon rains continue to fall. Pray for Tearfund partners as they respond to the needs of the communities where they serve.

Friday: Tearfund and young people. We give thanks for the work, enthusiasm, and determination of Tearfund's young people. 245 young people who have been trained in the Mbire Garden Project in Zimbabwe are now growing, and some are starting their own gardening projects. We pray for them and other young people who are taking initiatives and learning through other Tearfund projects.

Saturday: Let us pray for all our brothers and sisters in Christ around the world joining them in prayers to bring God's Kingdom here on earth, praying for love, justice and peace to reign.

Lord God, Heavenly Father, hear our prayers for Your children and Your world.
