CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

Some say that you don't have to be a member of the church to be a Christian; true, but it is much harder to be one on your own. It is good to belong to the Church Family - the family of God - we all need the Church, and the Church certainly needs each one of us. We also need one another.

'I am not good enough to be a member.'

We have all heard this said before, in truth none of us is perfect and that is why we come to Church to seek God's guidance through our worship, Bible reading, prayers and in singing praises.

Membership requires a commitment, and as a member you will be expected to attend church services regularly, and to attend Church Meeting. Church meetings are held in January, March, May, July, September and November on the last Thursday of the month.

To become a member of the Church you will need to affirm your faith in Jesus Christ, to love Him or a desire to love Him and to get to know Him more.

You may find that after a time you are asked to serve the Church in other ways too. Duties, Groups and maybe Eldership.

The Church meeting is the authority for all of the local Church affairs. Goring URC works closely with other Christian Churches of other denominations in the neighbourhood.
