DAILY PRAYERS for Pentecost week

Sunday: On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptised with water, but in a few days you will be baptised with the Holy Spirit."

Monday: Let us pray for God's Spirit to lead us in the coming week, month and year - that we may follow his guidance for all that we do.

Friday: Let us pray for our leaders and governments, that they may let the Spirit move and receive his wisdom for the way to go for peace and prosperity for everyone.

Saturday: "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams... I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below"
